


# How to download the content and copy in the content path


**Step1:-** Open the below URL


**Step2:-** you can select the language wise content folder for downloading.




**Step3:-** You can download individual files or the entire content folder by selecting one at a time.




**Step4:-** Open the downloaded content's folder once it has finished downloading.



**Step5:-** Right click on the downloaded Zip file and extract the folder to required destination




**Step6:-** Copy all of the content from the extracted file.



**Step7:-** Do the LF/Center Login




**Step8:-** Click on the “Management” Tab
