



## Steps to Download and Paste Reference Material


1. Go to Google chrome search → [alcreadiness.mkcl.org](http://alcreadiness.mkcl.org)




2. Click on **MS-CIT Downloads** card




3. Click on **MS-CIT Job Readiness Content 2023** card

5. Alternatively, you can click the download all files button and choose any language folder.








## 7. Click on extracted file
