



Solution:

Step 1: Search the command prompt and run as administration.




Step 2: Open the command prompt and type below command.

wmic bios get serialnumber.



Step 3: after running this command, you'll get a number. If you don't get a number, your wmic is corrupted.

(If Your WMIC is corrupted; follow the below-given steps.)

Step 4: Download the WMIC by following the below link.
